

SCA Versatility Title requirements:

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To honor those individual Samoyeds that conform to the breed standard and have demonstrated outstanding abilities and characteristics in multiple venues, in accordance with the history and heritage of the Samoyed as a versatile working dog.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 In order to receive the Versatility Award, a Samoyed must be registered with The American Kennel Club and must be owned by an SCA member in good standing at the time of application.

3.0 REQUIREMENTS

3.1 The Versatile Samoyed shall be an AKC conformation champion of record, AND shall have completed EITHER an AKC Obedience Title OR an AKC agility title, OR an AKC herding title above the PT or HT level, OR an AKC tracking title AND an SCA Master Working Samoyed Degree.

4.0 DOCUMENTATION

4.1 Copies of the certificates or other documentation for these degrees shall be provided to the Versatility Title Committee.

5.0 ADMINISTRATION

5.1 The Versatility Award shall be administered by a Versatility Award chairperson. This person shall be responsible for publishing information on this Award in the SCA Bulletin and SCA website, communicating with SCA members about the award, receiving the documentation, sending the award certificates, presenting the award at the SCA annual banquet and reporting to the BOG and the membership.
